




Violin making and bow making in the spotlight








A unique event, on the scale of a city

If the announcement of the competition provokes real enthusiasm among luthiers and bow makers, it is because the name of Mirecourt still resonates today as one of the high places of instrumental craftsmanship, both among professionals and amateurs. The city is home to the National School of Violin Making, a rare and precious institution: it is the only public violin making school in France.

Visitors will have the opportunity to live a unique and precious experience in Mirecourt, a true immersion in the world of violin making and bow making.



From one exhibition to another, from one conference to the next, between the various violin-making and bow-making workshops in the city, the National School of Violinmaking, the Museum of French Violinmaking and Bow-making and its annexes, or even to go to places of exchange and conviviality around the Madon, visitors can stroll to discover Mirecourt and its history.




